

DRESS CODE - UNIFORM

DRESS CODE – UNIFORM, PE, Etc:

We take pride in the appearance of our students. We expect our students to maintain the type of appearance that is not distracting to others nor disturb the orderly educational process of the school.

All students are expected to be neat and clean. Parents are asked to cooperate in this matter as it is unfair to reprimand a child for his/her parents' neglect. All students are expected to be dressed in the uniform stated below.

Boys and Girls K-8:

<u>Shoes</u>

Comfortable, sturdy athletic shoes in good repair in basic colors, (no sparkled, or lighted shoes).

Socks (Boys)

Plain white, navy, black crew socks (above the ankle). No logos.

Socks (Girls)

Plain white, navy or black knee socks or **crew** socks (**above** the ankle). No logos.

Shirt (K-4- Elementary):

Plain white knit (long or short sleeve) polo shirt with pointed collar. Shirts are to be tucked in at all times and should be <u>long enough to stay tucked</u> in at all times. Polo shirts with SJA on them may be worn as a uniform shirt. Solid, white T-shirts (short or long sleeved) may be worn under the polo shirt.

Shirt (5-8 – Jr. High):

Students in junior high (Grades 5, 6, 7 and 8th) will wear a plain, light blue (long or short sleeve) polo shirt. Shirts are to be tucked in at all times and should be long enough to stay tucked in at all times. Polo shirts with SJA on them may be worn as a uniform shirt. Solid, white T-shirts (short or long sleeved) may be worn under the polo shirt.

Shorts (K-8)

Dark, navy twill uniform dress shorts with belt loops. Grades 1-8 wear a plain, leather-type belt; black or navy color. The shorts should be as long as the bottom middle finger when standing straight, or to the knee. Shorts are worn based on the weather.

Slacks

Dark navy twill dress pants with belt loops. Grades K-8 wear a plain leather—type belt; black, or navy color. The hem must be above the sole of the shoe, yet longer than the ankle

Sweatshirt/Hoodie

Only navy glue crew neck sweatshirts or hoodies with the school crest, may be worn in school.

Sweater

Navy crew neck or v-neck cardigan sweaters may be worn.

Hair (Boys)

Hair should be neat and well groomed. Hair must be neatly cut, out of the eyes at all times, and off the collar. No colored hair.

Hair (Girls)

Hair should be neat and well groomed. Out of the eyes, and no dangling hair covering the face is acceptable.

Jewelry (Boys)

A small religious medal and watches (without alarms) may be worn. Rings or earrings are not permitted.

Jewelry (Girls)

A small religious medal and watches (without alarms), one pair of small button-type earrings for girls with pierced ears and no multiple piercings. *Make-up and nail polish are not permitted*.

Jumper (Girls, K-4)

Girls K-4 wear a blue/white plaid jumper. Jumper length must touch the floor when kneeling. Shorts (*any color*) are to be worn under the jumper at all times. Solid black, white or navy leggings or tights to the ankle with no patterns or cut outs or designs may be worn under the jumpers.

Skirt (Girls, 5, 6, 7 & 8th)

Girls 5th-8th may wear a blue/white plaid uniform skirt. Skirt length must touch the floor when kneeling. Shorts (any color) are to be worn under the skirt at all times. Solid black, white or navy leggings or tights to the ankle with no patterns or cut outs may be worn under the jumpers.

PE Uniform:

On the student's designated PE day, students K-8 will come to school wearing their PE uniform which is: Summer: school shirt, and knee length navy twill uniform shorts.

Winter: school shirt, and navy or black plain sweatpants (no logos)

The school is the final judge of the suitability of grooming and clothing. The school reserves the right to prohibit any type of dress not specifically mentioned in this policy, if they feel it is not appropriate for the school. Parents may be called to bring a change of clothes to school if necessary.
